

## **Appendix: Key Occupations according to the Hessian Ministry for Social Affairs and Integration**

Childcare in daycare centers is maintained for children if their parents (one parent) or their single parent has one of the following key occupations:

- Members of the police enforcement service
- Employees of the federal state who work for the police headquarters and carry out enforcement tasks
- Full-time and volunteer members of fire departments
- Employees of public health authorities
- Judges as well as public prosecutors, judicial public prosecutors
- Law enforcement officers
- Emergency services staff
- Helpers of the federal agency THW
- Aid workers in civil protection
- Employees in health care facilities in accordance with section 23 (3) sentence 1 numbers 1 and 3 to 7 and 11 Infection Protection Act:
  - hospitals,
  - preventive or rehabilitation facilities in which medical care comparable to that of hospitals is provided,
  - dialysis facilities,
  - day clinics,
  - maternity facilities,
  - treatment or care facilities that are comparable to one of the facilities mentioned in numbers 1 to 6,
  - outpatient care and nursing services (according to Section 2 Paragraph 1 Clause 1 No. 1 of the Hessian Law on Care and Nursing Services)
- Employees in facilities in accordance with Section 36 Paragraph 1 No. 2 Infection Protection Act: Fully and partially inpatient facilities for the care and accommodation of elderly, disabled or people in need of care
- Employees who work in medical and nursing professions, in particular
  - geriatric nurses
  - geriatric care assistants
  - anesthesia assistants
  - doctors
  - pharmacists
  - disinfectors
  - healthcare and pediatric nurses
  - healthcare workers and nurses
  - midwives
  - nursing assistants
  - medical assistant
  - medical-technical laboratory assistants
  - medical-technical radiology assistants
  - medical-technical assistants for functional diagnostics
  - paramedics
  - surgical assistants
  - nurses and care attendants

- pharmaceutical-technical assistants
  - paramedics according to § 1 of the Paramedic Act
  - dentists
  - dental assistants
- Specialists in day care centers (nurseries, kindergarten, after-school care, cross-age institutions) according to § 25 HKJGB
  - Persons directly involved in the payment of cash benefits (includes cash benefits in accordance with SGB II, SGB III, Asylum Seekers Benefits Act)
  - Only if the employer provides proof that the legal guardian's activity is imperative: employees in sectors of the sector according to the VO for determining critical infrastructures

Critical infrastructures (CRITIS) are organisations or institutions that provide particularly important services for the supply of the general public in the following sectors and whose failure or impairment would lead to significant supply bottlenecks or threats to public security.

### **1. Energy sector (§ 2 BSI-KritisV)**

The energy sector includes electricity supply, gas supply, fuel and heating oil supply and district heating.

Electricity supply and gas supply are provided in the areas of generation, transmission and distribution of electricity as well as production, transport and distribution of gas. The fuel and heating oil supply is used in the areas of crude oil production and product manufacture, oil transportation as well as fuel and heating oil distribution rendered. The district heating supply is provided in the areas of district heating generation and distribution.

### **2. Water sector (§ 3 BSI-KritisV)**

The drinking water supply and the sewage supply belong to the water sector.

The drinking water supply is provided in the areas of extraction, treatment, distribution, control and monitoring of drinking water. Wastewater disposal is carried out in the areas of urban drainage, wastewater treatment and water discharge as well as control and monitoring.

### **3. Food sector (§ 4 BSI-KritisV)**

Food supply belongs to the food sector. This is done in the areas of food production and processing as well as food trade.

### **4. Information technology and telecommunications sector (§ 5 BSI-KritisV)**

The information technology and telecommunications sector includes voice and data transmission as well as data storage and processing.

The voice and data transmission is carried out in the areas of access, transmission, switching and control. Data storage and processing is performed in the areas of housing, IT hosting and trust services.

### **5. Health sector (§ 6 BSI-KritisV)**

The health sector includes inpatient and medical care, the supply of immediately life-sustaining medical devices that are consumer goods, the supply of prescription drugs and blood and plasma concentrates for use in or on the human body, and laboratory diagnostics.

Inpatient and medical care is provided in the areas of admission, diagnosis, therapy, accommodation / care and discharge. The supply of immediately life-supporting medical products that are consumer goods is provided in the areas of manufacture and supply. The supply of prescription drugs and blood and plasma concentrates for use in or on the human body is provided

in the areas of manufacture, distribution and supply. Laboratory diagnostics are carried out in the areas of transport and analytics.

#### **6. Sector finance and insurance (§ 7 BSI KritisV)**

The sector includes cash supply, card-based payment transactions, conventional payment transactions, the settlement and processing of securities and derivatives transactions, and insurance services. As far as possible, business should not be conducted in direct customer contact.

The cash supply is provided in the areas of authorisation to withdraw, transfer payment, debit customer account and cash logistics. Card-based payment transactions are carried out in the case of card-based payment transactions via interchange fees for card-based payment transactions in the areas of authorisation, introduction into payment transactions as well as debiting customer accounts and crediting to the payee's account. Conventional payment transactions are required for payment transactions by means of transfer and direct debit in the areas of acceptance of a transfer or direct debit, introduction into payment transactions and debiting and crediting the customer account.

The settlement of and accounting for securities and derivative transactions is carried out in the areas of settlement of securities transactions and derivatives, accounting for securities and accounting for money. Insurance services are provided in the area of claiming insurance benefits.

#### **7. Sector transport and traffic (§ 8 BSI KritisV)**

The sector includes passenger and freight transport. This is provided by the modes of transport aviation, rail transport, inland and shipping, road traffic and cross-mode in local public transport and in logistics.
